The First Hadeeth

Chapter: What is Mentioned about Magic

((اجْتَنِبُوا السَّبْعَ الْمُؤْبَقَاتِ)) وَمَا هُنَّ؟
((الشِّرْكَ بِاللَّهِ، وَالسِّحْرُ، وَقَتْلُ النَّفْسِ الَّتِي حَرَّمَ اللَّهُ إِلَّا
بِالْحَقِّ، وَأَكْلُ الرِّبَا، وَأَكْلُ مَالِ الْيَتِيمِ، وَالتَّوَلَّى يَوْمَ الزَّحْفِ،
وَقَذْفُ الْمُحْصَنَاتِ الْغَافِلَاتِ الْمُؤْمِنَاتِ.))

“Stay away from the seven destructive sins!” [What are they?] “*Shirk* with Allaah, magic, murdering those whom Allaah has prohibited their killing without right, taking *riba* (usury), taking orphans’ money, running away from the battle at the time of conflict, and accusing chaste yet naive believing women of illicit behavior.”
